TYPES OF CHRIST



Intro

"A type is a symbol that points forward to a greater or climactic realization. The later realization of the symbol is customarily called the antitype. For example, animal sacrifices are types pointing to the final sacrifice of Christ, who is the antitype. The tabernacle is a type pointing to Christ as the final temple, the antitype. The prefix anti- may confuse some people, because they expect it to indicate opposition rather than continuity. But in this context the prefix anti- has a meaning closer to "corresponding to." The antitype is the reality that corresponds to the type." - Vern Poythress

"When God told Noah to build the Ark to survive the flood He would send upon an exceedingly wicked world, He instructed Noah to put one door in the side of the Ark.
